## REENROLLMENT & RECRUITMENT

Just a reminder to be sure to reenroll your student for next year so that their seat is not given away! Even if you were just accepted last week, you will still need to reenroll.

### Here's how:

1. Go to -> [https://sktcs.schooladminonline.com/users/sign\\_in](https://sktcs.schooladminonline.com/users/sign_in)
2. Use the same email address that you used initially to register your students.
3. Complete the quick reenrollment form before February 1st!!

If you get a notice that says you need an authentication code you may not be using the same the email address as before. Simply, reset your password and you'll be good to go.

## BLOOMZ

Bloomz is a wonderful resource that we have at school to connect home and school. If you haven't already, please be sure to sign-up for Bloomz. - For sending emergency messages (i.e. - my mother will be picking up my son, or please tell Johnny to take the bus home)
- Letting the office know that your student will be late/absent
- Contacting the principal/front office staff (about anything)
- Asking for clarification on policies and/or procedures.

The replacement part came in before break and now we are waiting for the installers to complete the job. I am told that once they start it will only be two days until completion.
